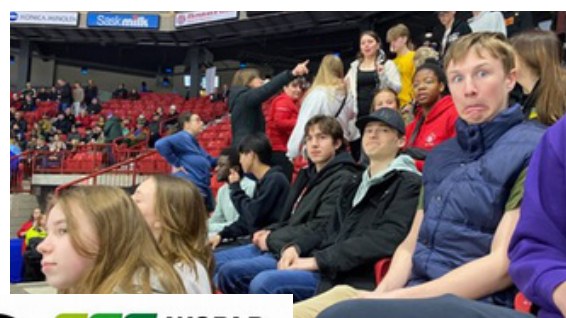
IMPORTANT GRAD INFO FOR GRADE 12 FAMILIES
