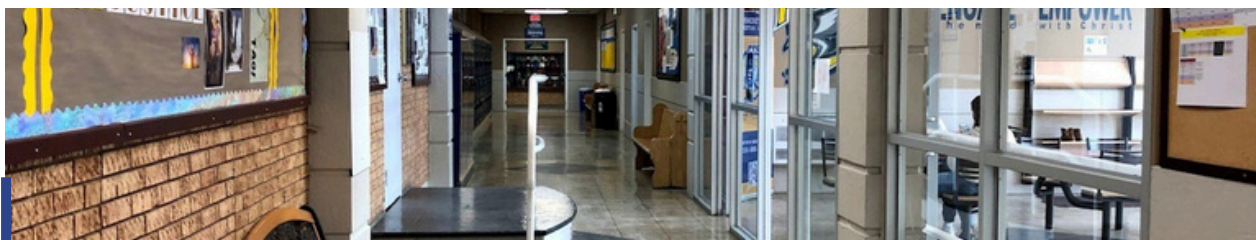

Did you know?

ORIGINS OF CURLING AND BASKETBALL

Curling originated in 16th-century Scotland, where players slid stones on ice toward a target. It formalized in the 19th century.

Basketball, invented in 1891 by a Canadian, Dr. James Naismith, in Springfield, Massachusetts, was designed as an indoor winter sport, involving shooting a ball into a peach basket, evolving into today's global game.
